There was a question at each layer about all things the Forum and Assembly did 2018.

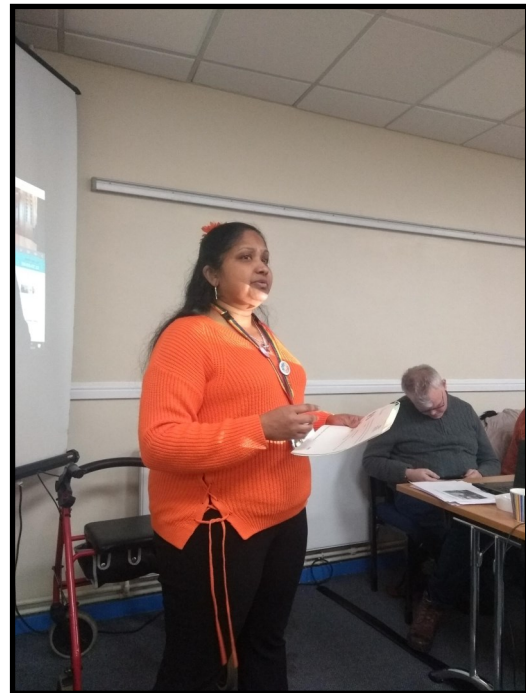
There was many layers because we did a lot of things 2018!

It's 8 hours a week and it's about training staff in mental health units about how to best work with people with learning disabilities.



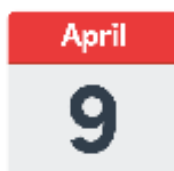

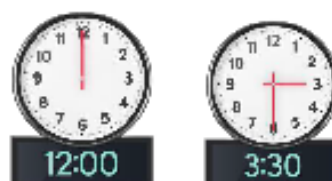
